Nevada Reinstates Voting Rights for Formerly Incarcerated Persons

Effective July 1, 2019

People who have been convicted of a crime and are not currently incarcerated, on parole, or probation may vote in Nevada if they are (1) U.S. citizens, (2) will be 18 or older on by the next election, (3) and have lived in Nevada for at least 30 days in their county and at least 10 days in their electoral district before the next election.

People who are at least 17 and meet the other criteria may preregister to vote.
