Advocate time valued at \$22/hour – For highest coverage year – total cost of \$170,835.50



We generally have approximately 30 active volunteer advocates and 4 staff advocates on the after-hours schedule at any given time. This is in addition to regular advocate staff that respond to calls during business hours.

Advocate Training:

We train from 40 – 70 advocates annually. Not all of these will become active volunteers. Generally speaking, however, training costs are similar regardless of size of training class, as planning, material and curriculum updating, staff and volunteer time, space, etc. is the same regardless of how many people participate.

Estimated training cost is approximately \$8,000 - \$10,000 per training, including staff and volunteer time, materials, curriculum updates and development. This is for a 50 hour/5 week training.

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
