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CRIMINAL INFORMATION

AARON D. FORD, Attorney General of the State of Nevada, and AMY K. STEELMAN, Senior Deputy Attorney General, in the name and by the authority of the State of Nevada, inform the above-entitled court that ARIELL OLIVIA DIX and NNEKA C. GIBNEY, contrary to the form, force and effect of statutes in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada, committed the following offenses:

COUNT I INTENTIONAL FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ADEQUATE RECORDS Gross Misdemeanor - NRS 422.570(1)

That the Defendants, ARIELL OLIVIA DIX and NNEKA C. GIBNEY, through a scheme or continuous course of conduct, upon causing claims to be submitted or payment received pursuant to the Nevada State Medicaid plan, did intentionally fail to maintain such records as are necessary to disclose fully the nature of the goods or services for which 2

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the claims were submitted or payment was received for at least 5 years after the date on which payment was received, to wit:

On or between about July 1, 2017, and September 30, 2017, Defendants were coowners of Lifetime Assistance LLC (Lifetime), located in Reno, Nevada, and submitted claims to Medicaid for reimbursement for services allegedly provided by Defendants and their employees to Medicaid recipients. Defendants intentionally failed to maintain accurate documentation, including but not limited to notes on the basic skills training or psychosocial rehabilitation services allegedly provided and legible records regarding who provided medication to the recipients. Additionally, Defendants used the same records to support claims with Nevada Medicaid and services paid for by Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services.

All of which was committed in Washoe County and constitutes a gross misdemeanor in violation of NRS 422.540.

INTENTIONAL FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ADEQUATE RECORDS Gross Misdemeanor - NRS 422.570(1)

That the Defendants, ARIELL OLIVIA DIX and NNEKA C. 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support claims with Nevada Medicaid and services paid for by Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services.

COUNT III INTENTIONAL FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ADEQUATE RECORDS Gross Misdemeanor - NRS 422.570(1)

That the Defendant, ARIELL OLIVIA DIX, through a scheme or continuous course of conduct, upon causing claims to be submitted or payment received pursuant to the Nevada State Medicaid plan, did intentionally fail to maintain such records as are necessary to disclose fully the nature of the goods or services for which the claims were submitted or payment was received for at least 5 years after the date on which payment was received, to wit:

On or between about January 1, 2018, and January 31, 2018, Defendant was a coowner of Lifetime Assistance LLC (Lifetime), located in Reno, Nevada, and submitted claims to Medicaid for reimbursement for services allegedly provided by Defendant and her employees to Medicaid recipients. Defendant intentionally failed to maintain accurate documentation, including but not limited to notes on the basic skills training or psychosocial rehabilitation services allegedly provided and legible records regarding who provided medication to the recipients. Additionally, Defendant used the same records to support claims with Nevada Medicaid and services paid for by Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services.

All of which was committed in Washoe County and constitutes a gross misdemeanor in violation of NRS 422.540.

All of which is contrary to the form, force and effect of the statutes in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada.
