## **Attorney General Laxalt Announces Sentencing of Medicaid Provider Company**

**Las Vegas, NV** – Today, Nevada Attorney General Adam Paul Laxalt announced that Solomon’s Porch Counseling Center, LLC (Solomon’s Porch) based in Las Vegas, was sentenced for Medicaid fraud, a category “D” felony. The fraud was committed between January 2013 and March 2015.

“This office will not allow Medicaid providers to cheat the state out of resources reserved for vulnerable individuals,” said Laxalt. “We will continue to aggressively prosecute these crimes to protect those in need of these services, as well as our taxpayers and the reputations of our professional agencies.”

Eighth Judicial District Court Judge Douglas E. Smith sentenced Solomon’s Porch to one count of Medicaid fraud, and placed the business on probation for five years. Solomon’s Porch was also ordered to pay \$44,000 in restitution.

The investigation began after the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) received information that Solomon’s Porch allegedly failed to provide mental health services to Medicaid recipients. The investigation revealed that the company knowingly generated false claims for reimbursement from Medicaid. Medicaid recipients denied that they had received the amount of services allegedly provided by Solomon’s Porch, and the company failed to maintain accurate records.

On behalf of the attorney general and the state, the MFCU investigates and prosecutes financial fraud by those providing healthcare services or goods to Medicaid patients. Persons or entities convicted of Medicaid fraud may also be administratively excluded from future Medicaid and Medicare participation.
