Dear Ms. Van Horn:

Our investigation of Mr. Clegg's complaint confirmed that the Board of Trustees for the Fernley Swimming Pool District (Trustees) have been lax with compliance of certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law (OML) that are for the purpose of ensuring transparency of public business, and any technical problems with distribution of its supporting materials in a timely fashion to the requesting public.

After discussions with Mr. Clegg and with your counsel Carrie Parker, we are satisfied that the Trustees are compliant, and that they have taken significant steps to enhance the public's knowledge and understanding of the district's public business. We are convinced that the Trustees take seriously the need for transparency and technical support for the interested public.

In this matter, the advice of counsel has obviously provided necessary technical oversight to rectify Mr. Clegg's claims (and perhaps others too) of the lack of documentation of meetings.
