1. Call to order and roll call of members.

Suzanne Ramos called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m., took roll call and established quorum.

2. Public comment.

There was no public comment at this time.

3. Approval of minutes from June 18, 2012 meeting. (For possible action.)

Suzanne Ramos asked for a motion on the minutes from the meeting on June 18, 2012. Christina Hernandez made the motion to approve the minutes. Kathleen Bergquist seconded the motion. Meeting minutes approved.

4. Review, discussion and possible action regarding education and outreach to Lesbian Gay Bisexual Transgender (LGBT) community. (For possible action.)

Christina Hernandez stated that things are moving forward with training next month for victim advocates as well as the second webinar for providers. Ms. Hernandez talked about the Pride festivities and get the word out about the programs at the event went well. Ms. Hernandez stated there are now two part-time staff members on board. Ms. Hernandez will be sending her contact list for the North to Lisa South, so Suzanne Ramos can follow-up as to what is going on in the North.

5. Review, discussion and possible action regarding education and outreach to the Asian Pacific Islander (API) community. (For possible action.)

Kathleen Bergquist stated that will be a participant in the Take Back the Night event at UNLV. Ms. Bergquist stated that the Clark County School Police had training on human trafficking as well as a presentation to the gang intervention team. Ms. Bergquist stated that she will be on the Women in Justice Panel for Boyd Law School in November 2012. Ms. Bergquist stated that a lead advocate was found for project resilience. Ms. Bergquist stated that working closely with the Clark County School Police to train police, personnel, staff, etc. around the issues of human trafficking and not just for the Asian Pacific Islander (API) community. Christina Hernandez stated that she met a contact from the Centers for Pacific Asian Family in California at the National Sexual Assault Conference and will send the contact information to Ms. Bergquist. Ms. Bergquist is aware of the Centers for Pacific Asian Family in California, but has not done anything collaborative.

6. Review, discussion and possible action regarding education and outreach to the African American community. (For possible action.)

Christine Brady stated that there is no update at this time.

7. Review, discussion and possible action regarding education and outreach to the Hispanic community. (For possible action.)

Suzanne Ramos stated that she has not been able to get in contact with Anya Arechiga Gonzalez for the PSA announcements to the Hispanic community. Ms. Ramos stated the last PSA announcements went out back in January or February 2012. Ms. Ramos stated that she is checking into other resources, radio and/or television, for outreach to the Hispanic community. Ms. Ramos will have an update at the next meeting.

8. Schedule future meetings & agenda items. (For possible action.)

Discussion on doing a collaborative project among the members. Kathleen Bergquist came up with a campaign idea called "DV Doesn't Discriminate". The collaborative campaign "DV Doesn't Discriminate" will be added to the agenda items. Ms. Prentice asked Ms. Ramos about the other agenda items and the remaining agenda items will remain the same. The next meeting will be held December 3, 2012 at 11:00 a.m.
