Marijuana Bill Draft Requests

(All from Sen. Tick Segerblom)

BDR-43: Authorizes local governments to enact ordinances allowing marijuana social clubs, events and concert arenas to allow the public use of marijuana.

BDR-185: Prohibits professional licensing boards from taking disciplinary action against licensees because of the licensees' professional involvement with marijuana.

BDR-321: Authorizes the Governor to enter into compacts with Indian tribes in Nevada concerning the regulation of marijuana and revises provisions relating to a tribal marijuana program in Nevada.

BDR-361: Provides for a medical Marijuana Patients' Bill of Rights.
