INSURANCE FRAUD

(Category D Felony - NRS 686A.2815/NRS 686A.291 and NRS 686A.292)

On or between about February 17, 2017 and March 27, 2017, Defendant, CHERYL LEE CONGDON, did without lawful authority, knowingly and willfully present or cause to be presented any statement as a part of, or in support of, a claim for payment or other benefits under a policy of insurance, knowing that the statement conceals or omits facts, or contains false or misleading information concerning any fact material to that claim; and/or act or fail to act with the intent of defrauding or deceiving an insurer, a reinsurer, a producer, a broker or any agent thereof, to obtain any proceeds or other benefits under a policy of insurance; and/or accept any proceeds or other benefits under a policy of insurance knowing that the proceeds or other benefits are derived from any of the foregoing acts or omissions, to wit:

The above-named defendant did so by reporting a property loss (jewelry) to Country Financial under homeowners insurance policy number AK4779792, when in truth and in fact, the property (jewelry) was not lost. As a result of the above-named defendant's wrongdoing, she accepted insurance proceeds or other benefits under Country Financial claim number 204-0027455.

On or between about February 10, 2018 and March 8, 2018, Defendant, CHERYL LEE CONGDON, did without lawful authority, knowingly and willfully present or cause to be presented any statement as a part of, or in support of, a claim for payment or other benefits under a policy of insurance, knowing that the statement conceals or omits facts, or contains false or misleading information concerning any fact material to that claim; and/or act or fail to act with the intent of defrauding or deceiving an insurer, a reinsurer, a producer, a broker or any agent thereof, to obtain any proceeds or other benefits under a policy of insurance, to wit:

The above-named defendant did so by reporting a property loss (jewelry) to Homesite Insurance Company under homeowners insurance policy number 34841920, when in truth and in fact, the property (jewelry) was not lost. As a result of the above-named defendant's wrongdoing, her claim under Homesite Insurance Company claim number 2278865 was denied.
