The Committee on Domestic Violence (Batterer's Treatment Certification Committee), is proposing the Adoption, Amendment, and Repeal of regulations pertaining to Chapter 228 of the Nevada Administrative Code.  - 3. 24 clients is impossible to work within 90 minutes
 - 4. One private counseling session per month (one on one)
 - 5. 228.210 Supervisors suggesting extra training for providers
 - 6. Get an updated study on the effectiveness of batterer's intervention programs
 - ii. The AG staff will send this list to the Committee for them to review in detail so action can be taken at the next meeting.
