NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

This document serves as notice of a public hearing regarding amendment to the regulations located in Chapter 228 of the Nevada Administrative Code Related to Qualifications of Supervisors and Providers of Treatment to Domestic Violence Batterers. The Committee on Domestic Violence Batterers' Treatment will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. **Thursday, November 17, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the following locations:

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the Amendment of regulations that pertain to Chapter 228.110 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.
 - The proposed amendment to NAC 228.110 revises the training requirements for supervisors and providers of domestic violence batterer's treatment.

2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved.
 - The current status of NAC 228.110 includes training requirements which are not available and thereby stymies applicants from obtaining certification as a provider.

3. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public.
 - (a) Both adverse and beneficial effects; and
 - The Committee does not foresee or expect any adverse or beneficial economic impacts upon the small business which it regulates.
 - (b) Both immediate and long-term effects.
 - The Committee does not foresee or expect any immediate or indirect economic benefits to the small businesses which it regulates.
4. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.
 - The Committee does not foresee any additional costs to enforce the proposed amendment to the regulation because the regulation is already in effect.
5. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.
 - Does not apply.
6. If the regulation is required pursuant to federal law, a citation and description of the federal law.
 - Does not apply.
7. If the regulation includes provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.
 - Does not apply.
8. Whether the proposed regulation establishes a new fee or increases an existing fee.
 - The proposed amendment to NAC 228.110 does not provide for a new or increased fee.

A concerted effort was made to determine the impact of the regulatory amendment on small businesses. The Committee staff determined that this regulatory amendment will not have an effect on small businesses.
