The CDV adopts regulations for the evaluation, certification and monitoring of programs for the treatment of persons who commit domestic violence.</p> <p>The Attorney General appoints the members of the CDV. The CDV is comprised of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ One staff member of a program for victims of domestic violence ▪ One staff member of a program for the treatment of persons who commit domestic violence ▪ One representative from an office of the district attorney with experience in prosecuting criminal offenses ▪ One representative from an office of the city attorney with experience in prosecuting criminal offenses ▪ One law enforcement officer ▪ One provider of mental health care ▪ Two victims of domestic violence ▪ One Justice of the Peace or Municipal Court Judge ▪ At least two members of the Committee must be residents of a county whose population is less than 100,000 <p>The Committee meets quarterly and may meet at other times upon the call of the Chairman. Any five members of the Committee constitute a quorum for the purpose of voting. A majority vote of the quorum is required to take action with respect to any matter.</p>
