Did you lose the right to vote because of a criminal conviction?

If so, this information is for you.

If you are not currently incarcerated, you have the right to vote in Nevada, if you are a U.S. citizen, who is 18 by the election, and meet the residency requirements.

In 2019, Nevada lawmakers passed new laws that gave back the right to vote to Nevadans convicted of a crime as long as they are not currently incarcerated **effective July 1, 2019.**
