16 **CRIMINAL INFORMATION**

17 The State of Nevada, by and through legal counsel, ADAM PAUL LAXALT, Nevada
18 Attorney General, and MARK J. KRUEGER, Senior Deputy Attorney General, in the name
19 and by the authority of the State of Nevada, informs the court that KEVIN JESUS
20 CUMMINGS, the above named Defendant, has committed the criminal offenses of
21 **SUBMITTING FALSE CLAIMS: MEDICAID FRAUD**, a category D felony violation of NRS
22 422.540(1)(a) and NRS 422.540(2)(a) (Count 1); and **THEFT**, a category C felony violation of
23 NRS 205.0832(1)(c) and NRS 205.0835(3) (Count 2); within Washoe County, State of
24 Nevada, in the manner following:

25 Nova Behavioral Services, LLC ("Nova") maintained an agreement with Medicaid to be
26 a provider of mental health services to Medicaid recipients. At all times relevant to these
27 allegations, Nova maintained an office location at 4860 Vista Blvd., Suite 200, Sparks,
28 Nevada. Defendant was Nova's owner and administrator.

1 From on or about January 2013 through May 2014, Nova submitted several claims to
2 Medicaid for reimbursement under the Medicaid number of several Medicaid recipients.
3 Through these claims, Nova represented that it had provided certain mental health services
4 these recipients.

6 **COUNT 1**
7 **SUBMITTING FALSE MEDICAID CLAIMS**
8 **NRS 422.540 (1)(a) and NRS 422.540 (2)(a)**
9 **Felony, Category D**

10 Defendant, through a scheme or continuous course of conduct, with intent to defraud,
11 intentionally made or caused to be made claims for payment from Medicaid that Defendant
12 knew were false, to wit:

13 Defendant knowingly made or caused fraudulent claims for reimbursement to be
14 generated and submitted for payment by Medicaid. The claims to Medicaid asserted that
15 certain services were provided to the Medicaid recipients and requested reimbursement for
16 such provisions of services. Instead, the Medicaid recipients did not receive the particular
17 services from Nova that Nova claimed were delivered to the Medicaid recipients. All of which
18 acts aggregated to an amount in excess of \$650.00.

19 **COUNT 2**
20 **THEFT**
21 **NRS 205.0832(1)(c) and 205.0835(3)**
22 **Felony, Category C**

23 Defendant, through a scheme or continuous course of conduct, without lawful
24 authority, knowingly obtained property of another person by a material misrepresentation with
25 the intent to deprive the person of the property, to wit:

26 Defendant knowingly submitted or caused to be submitted claims for services allegedly
27 provided to Medicaid recipients. The claims to Medicaid asserted that certain services were
28 provided to the Medicaid recipients and requested reimbursement for such provisions of
services. Instead, the Medicaid recipients did not receive the particular services from Nova
that Nova claimed were delivered to the Medicaid recipients. Defendant obtained payment

1 through communication of these material misrepresentations to Medicaid in excess of 650.00
2 but less than \$3,500.00.

3 All of which is contrary to the form, force and effect of the statutes in such cases made
4 and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada.
