17 CATHERINE CORTEZ MASTO, Attorney General, through Jamie J. Resch, Acting  
18 Chief Deputy Attorney General, informs this Honorable Court that Derland Blake, the  
19 Defendant above named, has committed the felony offense of ASKING OR RECEIVING  
20 BRIBE BY A PUBLIC OFFICER (Category "C" Felony – NRS 197.040), within the County of  
21 Clark, State of Nevada, as follows:

22 **COUNT ONE**

23 **ASKING OR RECEIVING BRIBE BY A PUBLIC OFFICER**

24 **(Category "C" Felony – NRS 197.040)**

25 That the defendant, **DERLAND BLAKE**, did, while executing the functions of a public  
26 officer as a person employed by or acting for the State, unlawfully and feloniously, ask or  
27 receive, directly or indirectly, compensation, gratuity or reward, or any promise thereof, upon  
28 an agreement or understanding that his vote, opinion, judgment, action, decision or other

1 official proceeding will be influenced thereby, or that he will do or omit any act or proceeding  
2 or in any way neglect or violate any official duty, to wit: On or about May 9, 2014, the  
3 defendant asked and/or received cash or compensation in order to use his position as a  
4 corrections officer with Nevada Department of Corrections to smuggle cellular telephones,  
5 food, and/or alcohol into High Desert State Prison, and/or provided the contraband and  
6 cellular telephones to inmates at the institution.

7 All of which is contrary to the form, force and effect of statutes in such cases made and  
8 provided against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada.
