Defendant ALICA RUIZ, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, either by virtue of her own actions or by the actions of her agents or employees, without lawful authority, with the Defendant being criminally liable under one or more of the following principles of criminal liability, to-wit: (1) by directly committing the crime; and/or (2) by aiding or abetting in the

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commission of this crime, with the intent that this crime be committed, by providing counsel and/or encouragement and by entering into a course of conduct whereby RUIZ promised to engage in a "short sale buyback" with ALICIA RODRIGUEZ; and/or (3) pursuant to a conspiracy to commit this crime;

did knowingly control property of another person with the intent to deprive that person of the property; and/or convert, make an unauthorized transfer of an interest in, or without authorization control property of another person, or used the property of another person entrusted to them or placed in their possession for a limited, authorized period of determined or prescribed duration or for a limited use; and/or obtain property of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property, and the value of said property was \$650 or more, to wit:

In or about May 2012, Defendant knowingly, and with the intent to deprive ALICIA RODRIGUEZ of her property, misrepresented that ALICIA RUIZ, and/or JESSICA SALINAS, and/or MARIA CERVANTES would buy ALICIA RODRIGUEZ's home in exchange for an upfront fee, and would thereafter sell said home to ALICIA RODRIGUEZ at a reduced price. Relying on that misrepresentation, ALICIA RODRIGUEZ paid Defendants a total of approximately \$6,300. However, Defendant never actually attempted to buy the home for ALICIA RODRIGUEZ.

All of which constitutes the crime of THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$650.00 OR MORE, a category "C" felony in violation of NRS 205.0832 and 205.0835.

## COUNT TWO THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$650 OR MORE CATEGORY "C" felony - NRS 205.0832, 205.0835

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terms of a "short sale buyback" with ELENA ZAMUDIO; and/or (3) pursuant to a conspiracy to commit this crime;

did knowingly control property of another person with the intent to deprive that person of the property; and/or convert, make an unauthorized transfer of an interest in, or without authorization control property of another person, or used the property of another person entrusted to them or placed in their possession for a limited, authorized period of determined or prescribed duration or for a limited use; and/or obtain property of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property, and the value of said property was \$3,500 or more, to wit:

From about March 2012 to November 2012, Defendant RUIZ, knowingly, and with the intent to deprive ELENA ZAMUDIO of her property, misrepresented that Defendant and/or JESSICA SALINAS and/or MARIA CERVANTES would buy ELENA ZAMUDIO's home in exchange for an upfront fee, and would thereafter sell said home to ELENA ZAMUDIO at a reduced price. Relying on that misrepresentation, ELENA ZAMUDIO paid Defendant and/or JESSICA SALINAS and/or MARIA CERVANTES a total of approximately \$9,975. However, Defendant never actually attempted to buy the home for ELENA ZAMUDIO....
