COUNT 1 THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE Category "B" Felony - NRS 205.0832

That the Defendant, DAVID A. THOMAS ID#1870907, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, did without lawful authority knowingly obtain property or services of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property or services, and the value of said property was \$3,500 or more, to wit:

On or about May 4, 2015 through October 1, 2015, Defendant, without lawful authority and knowingly, obtained \$3,500 or more from Rogelio Valenzuela Garcia and Rosario Aguilar Leyva by falsely informing them that:

- he was a former FBI agent; and/or
- he would provide them with immigration services by which they would have permanent legal resident status in the United States,

with the intent to deprive Valenzuela Garcia and Valenzuela of said money.

All of which constitutes the crime of THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE, a category "B" felony, in violation NRS 205.0832.

COUNT 2 THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE Category "B" Felony - NRS 205.0832

That the Defendant, DAVID A. THOMAS ID#1870907, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, did without lawful authority knowingly obtain property or services of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property or services, and the value of said property was \$3,500 or more, to wit:

On or about August 6, 2014 through February 28, 2016, Defendant, without lawful authority and knowingly, obtained \$3,500 or more from Sergio Ramirez Trinidad by falsely informing him that:

- he was a former FBI agent; and/or
- he would obtain for Ramirez Trinidad legal resident status in the United States, as well as a driver license,

with the intent to deprive Ramirez Trinidad of said money.

All of which constitutes the crime of THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE, a category "B" felony, in violation NRS 205.0832.

COUNT 3 THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE Category "B" Felony - NRS 205.0832

That the Defendant, DAVID A. THOMAS ID#1870907, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, did without lawful authority knowingly obtain property or services of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property or services, and the value of said property was \$3,500 or more, to wit:

On or about January 30, 2015 through June 17, 2015, Defendant, without lawful authority and knowingly, obtained \$3,500 or more from Raul Saenz Lara by falsely informing him that:

- he was a former FBI agent; and/or
- he would provide Raul Saenz Lara with immigration services by which Raul Saenz Lara's son would have permanent legal resident status in the United States,

with the intent to deprive Saenz Lara of said money.

All of which constitutes the crime of THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE, a category "B" felony, in violation NRS 205.0832.

COUNT 4 THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE Category "B" Felony - NRS 205.0832

That the Defendant, DAVID A. THOMAS ID#1870907, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, did without lawful authority knowingly obtain property or services of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property or services, and the value of said property was \$3,500 or more, to wit:

On or about January 30, 2015 through June 17, 2015, Defendant, without lawful authority and knowingly, obtained \$3,500 or more from Raul Omar Saenz-Alvarez by falsely informing him that:

- he was a former FBI agent; and/or
- he would provide him with immigration services by which he would have permanent legal resident status in the United States,

with the intent to deprive Saenz-Alvarez of said money.

All of which constitutes the crime of THEFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,500 OR MORE, a category "B" felony, in violation NRS 205.0832.

COUNT 5

MULTIPLE TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING FRAUD OR DECEIT IN COURSE OF ENTERPRISE OR OCCUPATION Category "B" Felony - NRS 205.377

That the Defendant(s), DAVID A. THOMAS ID#1870907, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, did, in the course of an enterprise or occupation, knowingly and with the intent to defraud, engaged in an act, practice or course of business or employed a device, scheme or artifice which operated or would have operated as a fraud or deceit upon a person by means of a false representation or omission of a material fact that: (a) the person knew to be false or omitted; (b) the person intended another to rely on; and (c) resulted in a loss to any person who relied on the false representation or omission, in at least two transactions that had the same or similar pattern, intents, results, accomplices, victims or methods of commission, or were otherwise interrelated by distinguishing characteristics and were not isolated incidents within 4 years and in which the aggregate loss or intended loss was more than \$650, to wit:

On or about August 6, 2014 through February 28, 2016, in and through the course of an enterprise doing business as Can You Hear Me Crying, Defendant knowingly and with the intent to defraud, obtained thousands of dollars from Rogelio Valenzuela Garcia, Rosario Aguilar Leyva, Sergio Ramirez Trinidad, Raul Saenz Lara, and Raul Omar Saenz-Alvarez by means of knowingly and falsely representing to said individuals that Defendant was a former FBI agent and/or that he would provide them with immigration services, resulting in a loss of more than \$650. The allegations contained in counts one through four are hereby repeated and incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this count.

All of which constitutes the crime of MULTIPLE TRANSACTIONS INVOLVE FRAUD OR DECEIT IN COURSE OF ENTERPRISE OR OCCUPATION, a category "B" felony, in violation NRS 205.377.
