That the defendant, TRUNG ANH LE, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, on or between March 11, 2015 and March 24, 2015, knowingly, and with the intent to defraud, misrepresented himself as the true and correct owners of real property located at

by impersonating the true owners, ________, as a way to secure hard money loans in the amount of \$180,000.00 via an electronic wire transfer from ROBERT C. WELCH, III. As a result of the Defendant's misrepresentations, Ticor Title filed with the Clark County Recorder's Office three (3) Quitclaim Deeds and three (3) Deeds of Trust with Assignment of Rents signed by the Defendant. However, these properties were not owned by the Defendant, nor did he have authority to cloud title or otherwise encumber the properties. Defendant was aware of the misrepresentations of ownership/authority over these properties when he caused the documents to be filed with the Clark County Recorder's Office.

All of which constitutes the crime of PATTERN OF MORTGAGE LENDING FRAUD, a category "B" felony in violation of NRS 205.372.

All of which is contrary to the form, force and effect of the statutes in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the state of Nevada.
