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## COUNT ONE

## INTENTIONAL FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ADEQUATE RECORDS [NRS 422.570(1) Gross Misdemeanor]

Defendant, either by virtue of her own actions, or by and through her agents operating at her direction, upon submitting a claim for or upon receiving payment for goods or services pursuant to Medicaid, intentionally failed to maintain such records, for at least 5 years after the date on which payment was received, as are necessary to disclose fully the nature of the goods or services for which the claims were submitted or payment received, to wit:

From about January 5, 2015 through May 27, 2016, in Clark County, Nevada, Defendant, either by virtue of her own actions, or by and through her agents operating at her direction, submitted claims to Medicaid for payment of services purportedly provided to the Medicaid Recipients, and for those claims, intentionally failed to maintain accurate or true records, such as: dates, times or length of services provided; provider names; or types of services that were purportedly provided.

All of which is contrary to form, force and effect of the statutes in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada. Furthermore, complainant makes this declaration subject to the penalty of perjury.
