## **COUNT I**

That the defendant, STORMY ROBERTSON, on or between June 23, 2019, and July 24, 2019, did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously cause A.S., a child who was less than 18 years of age, to suffer unjustifiable physical pain or mental suffering as a result of abuse or neglect, to wit: sexual exploitation, and/or cause A.S. to be placed in a situation where he or she may have suffered physical pain or mental suffering as a result of the abuse or neglect, to wit: sexual exploitation, by forcing, allowing, and/or encouraging A.S. to solicit for or engage in prostitution.

**COUNT 2** ATTEMPT SEX TRAFFICKING Category "C" Felony – NRS 201.300(2) and NRS 193.330 That the defendant, STORMY ROBERTSON, on or between June 23, 2019, and July 24, 2019, did willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously attempt to induce, cause, recruit, harbor, transport, provide, obtain or maintain A.S. to engage in prostitution, by means of force, fraud or coercion.
