Dear Mr. Brooks:

This Office requested the Genoa Town Advisory Board (Board) to respond to your letter complaint of a violation of the Open Meeting Law (OML). Your complaint alleged that the Board's failure to send you notice of its September 13, 2012 evening meeting was a violation of the OML.

Enclosed with this letter is the explanation from the Chair of the Board, Dave Whitgob, for the unfortunate failure to send you an agenda by mail. There is no evidence that the failure was intentional or deliberate. It was inadvertent.

The Board's September 13, 2012 meeting was cancelled for the reasons explained in Mr. Whitgob's letter attached.

Cancellation of the meeting satisfies the Board's determination that corrective action needed to be taken and it satisfies this Office's review of the complaint that no violation occurred. Because the meeting was cancelled no action occurred and no violation occurred. Corrective action by the Board remedied the alleged violation. OPEN MEETING LAW MANUAL § 11.01-11.04 (11th ed. 2012).


