

What is the Allowable Administrative Percentage?

Administrative Allowability is limited to 5%. This includes all staff and overhead that cannot be directly tied to the program but are necessary for the program to run effectively.

We see operating is allowed in the budget. Is this part of the 5%, or is the admin separate and can we request support for operating and admin?

Support for operating and personnel can be requested. Administrative costs are costs that cannot be directly tied to the program but are necessary for the program to run effectively. These should be identified costs on the Budget Narrative.

Could you confirm the allowable rate of admin costs? We noticed that the summary tab on the budget narrative shows 10%, but we understood it to be 5% from the webinar, so we want to make sure we're applying the correct one. Also, is it okay to include the admin rate under the indirect section of the budget narrative tab, or should it go in a different section?

Administrative Allowability is limited to 5%. This includes all staff and overhead that cannot be directly tied to the program but are necessary for the program to run effectively. The Budget Narrative is utilized for all our awards and Federal Indirect de minimis is 10%. This award does not allow Indirect as it is not a Federal award. Administrative Expenses should be placed under the category that best fits with an identifier stating that it is part of the 5% Administrative costs.

How much is the funding pool?

There is \$9,500,000 total available for the three-year period (October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2029). We are anticipating on awarding multiple awards from these funds.
