1. Review of the Funding Opportunity

3. Required Meetings and Training

Funded agencies agree to participate in required meetings, webinars, conference calls, and training opportunities conducted or sponsored by the OAG. These activities are intended to support compliance, promote best practices, and strengthen statewide coordination.

4. Collaboration and Networking

Funded agencies agree to participate in statewide collaboration and networking opportunities facilitated by the OAG. Agencies may be asked to engage with other funded agencies to strengthen partnerships, improve referral processes, and enhance service delivery to victims throughout Nevada.

5. Emergency Preparedness

Agencies providing direct services to clients shall maintain current emergency preparedness policies appropriate to their operations, including disaster response and evacuation procedures.

- Agencies providing office-based client services shall maintain evacuation procedures for staff and clients at each service location.
- Staff shall receive periodic training on applicable emergency procedures.

6. Cost Allocation Plan

Applicant agencies shall submit a current cost allocation plan that identifies all actual, pending, and anticipated funding sources, including federal, state, local, and private funding. The plan shall demonstrate how organizational costs, personnel, and shared expenses are allocated across funding sources.

7. Availability of Funds

All awards are contingent upon the availability of funding, the successful execution of all required award documents, and approval by the Nevada Office of the Attorney General.
