<u>Web:</u> http://ag.nv.gov Be aware of your surroundings. Report terrorism-related suspicious activity to law enforcement. Things you should report include:



Cyberattack: Disrupting or compromising an organization's information technology systems



Express or Implied Threat(s): Threatening to commit a crime that could harm or kill people or damage a facility, infrastructure, or secured site



Misrepresentation: Presenting false information or documents to conceal possible illegal activity



Recruiting/Financing: Funding suspicious or criminal activity or recruiting people to participate in criminal or terrorist activity



Surveillance: A prolonged interest in or taking pictures/videos of personnel, facilities, security features, or infrastructure in an unusual or covert manner



Testing or Probing of Security: Investigating or testing a facility's security or IT systems or weaknesses of the target



Theft/Loss Diversion: Stealing or diverting items—such as equipment, uniforms, or badges—that belong to a facility or secured site
