The FRT Subcommittee shall review and discuss the proposed Fatality Review Protocol and submit its recommendations to the Committee for its approval.

Pursuant to NRS 228.495(1), the Committee shall perform the following:

- 1) Examine the trends and patterns of deaths of victims of crimes that constitute domestic violence in the State;
- 2) Determine the number and types of incidents the Committee wishes to review;
- 3) Make policy and other recommendations for the prevention of deaths from crimes that constitute domestic violence;
- 4) Engage in activities to educate the public, providers of services to victims of domestic violence and policymakers concerning deaths from crimes that constitute domestic violence and strategies for intervention and prevention of such crimes; and
- 5) Recommend policies, practices and services to encourage collaboration and reduce the number of deaths from crimes that constitute domestic violence.

The FRT Subcommittee shall review and discuss the proposed data collection tool, which will aid the Committee in performing the duties outlined in NRS 228.495(1), and shall submit its recommendations to the Committee for its approval.
