CHAIR'S REPORT June 18, 2024

Committee on Domestic Violence (CDV)

- 1. The CDV has held one meeting since the last meeting of the Advisory Council for Prosecuting Attorneys (May 7, 2024). District Attorney Ingram's presentation on how the current/upcoming framework for the prison credit/time served system is detrimental to victims/survivors, but was tabled to a future meeting due to an active investigation.
- 2. At a future meeting, the CDV will vote to possibly absorb the work of the Advisory Committee on Rights of Survivors of Sexual Assault (would still need legislative approval).
- 3. The CDV is still working with the Nevada District Attorney Association's Best Practices Subcommittee on the State of Nevada Domestic Violence Prosecution Best Practices Guidelines.

Statewide Substance Use Response Working Group (SURG)

Since the last meeting of the Advisory Council in March 2024, the SURG or one of its subcommittees has met nine times. Specifically, at the April 10, 2024 meeting, the SURG was presented with a <u>review of expenditures</u> from the Fund for a Resilient Nevada, presented by the Department of Health and Human Services. The SURG also heard proposals at that meeting to <u>add additional voting members</u> to the Working Group, including a representative from the Nevada District Attorneys Association. The next meeting of the SURG is schedule for July 10, 2024.

Nevada Sentencing Commission

The Nevada Sentencing Commission has met twice since the last meeting on the Advisory Council in March 2024. During those two meetings, the Commission received reports and presentations on the budget for the Nevada Department of Corrections, a re-entry program at Truckee Meadows Community College, and a <u>proposed costs avoided formula</u>. The next meeting of the Sentencing Commission is scheduled for June 21, 2024.
