**CHAIR'S REPORT  
June 29, 2026**

**Committee on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault (CDVSA)**

The CDVSA had a meeting in April 2026, where it discussed tying data together from point of contact with law enforcement, through prosecution (including plea deals), incarceration, and/or potential re-arrests. The Nevada State Police Records, Communications and Compliance Division is helping the CDVSA gain access to this data. The Committee also discussed the NV S.A.V.E. system and how its implementation is progressing.

The CDVSA recently opened up membership applications for open positions (law enforcement, a sitting judge, and a sexual assault survivor). The Committee will be making all current voting members reapply after all open positions are filled. The Committee is seeking more rural representation from prosecutors when those applications are opened.

The Committee also decided to restructure the fatality review committee, as many cases that could be beneficial for review are either already being covered by local fatality review teams (Washoe, Clark, Elko), or are currently in the appeals process. The Committee is hoping to add in high contact cases as part of the review process, so it can discern ways to proactively prevent high risk cases from turning into fatalities as well.

**Statewide Substance Use Response Working Group (SURG)**

Since the last Chair's Report in March 2026, the SURG or one of its subcommittees has met 5 times. Most notably, the full working group voted on the inclusion of the recommendations by each of the three subcommittees at its June 10, 2026 meeting. **Nevada Sentencing Commission**

The Nevada Sentencing Commission (NSC) has not met since the Advisory Council's last meeting on March 30, 2026. The NSC will next meet on July 17, 2026.
