Public Service Announcement

- In 2019, Nevada lawmakers passed new laws that gave back the right to vote to formerly incarcerated persons as long as they are not currently incarcerated. •

In Nevada, as of July 1, 2019, if you:

1. are a U.S. citizen
2. are 18 by the next election
3. are not currently incarcerated
4. will have continuously resided before the next election
 - a. in Nevada at least 30 days in your county and
 - b. at least 10 days in your electoral district
